Introduction

Vancouver Tap Dance Society recognizes that there is a need to provide financial support for students who would like to join dance.

Named after VanTap's Founding Executive Director, Sas Selfjord, the scholarship fund exists to decrease the financial barrier of programs at VanTap's Academy and annual Festival.

Policy - Scholarships

Each year VanTap offers full and partial scholarships to offset fees in our Academy and Festival programming. The criteria for a bursary are as follows:

1. There is a financial need.
2. The student is committed to the program and will attend classes on a regular basis.
3. The Executive Director or Academy Manager recommends the student for support.
4. The fund is based on the support of donors, we try to support as many families as possible, based on our community's giving.

The scholarship only covers class tuition and does not include the costs of registration fees, costume fees, competition fees, rental fees, shoe rentals, or any other additional costs incurred by enrollment in any of the Academy or Festival's programs.
